For the third year in a row, the College of Education is organizing an international Culture Walk learning experience to Norway. Participants will tour the country; participate in service-learning activities and tour Norway's educational institutions. There are only **10** slots open for COE Students, so get your application in ASAP!

Dates of Trip: Monday, May 14 - Thursday, May 24, 2012

Requirements:

- Students will participate in pre-program meetings in February - May.
- Students must take this experience for course credit (undergrad and graduate credit options available).



Costs:

Students are responsible for a minimum of \$2,300 - this includes the plane ticket, lodging, tours, and transportation. This amount does *not* include meals or travel insurance; therefore students should plan on spending between \$2,300 to \$2,800 dollars on this *international travel experience*. Students also must enroll in TED 3000 Special Projects (3 credits undergraduates) or TED 8970 Independent Study (3 credits- graduates) and pay the costs of UNO tuition and fees (see the application for details). **Travel grants are available to offset some the costs.**

Application Deadline: On or before Friday, January 27, 2012.
